**1. Conferences**

**CHIVA/HYPNet parallel session at BHIVA**

CHIVA/HYPNet parallel sessions at BHIVA Autumn conference discussed – most are attending. Sexual health education resources for young adults with learning difficulties highlighted.

**2. AALPHI Update**

Recruitment has started in several centres. Plan for recruitment either to AALPHI or to seroconverter study to prevent duplication and Rebecca Hopes study captures similar data and will reduce the reporting required in those clinics involved in her study.

**3. Audit for 2013**

CF for Katia Prime

Excellent audit plan for 2013 but concerns expressed over primary outcome measures and difficulty in capturing those who receive psychology services but do not meet diagnostic criteria for major psychiatric disorders thereby potentially minimising service usage/need in at risk patients. **Tomas Campbell** will liaise with team at St Georges to look at how best this data can be captured whilst trying to keep data entry required by the centres participating to a realistic level. Concerns re lack of age definition and “transition clinic” definition as some centres define their transition clinic as 13-18 years, others 16-25 years.

**4. Transition outcomes study**

Due to start data entry next month at Marys and Georges with other centres to follow. Has been designated by NRES as a service evaluation so Rand D not required and any other centres interested to contact Rebecca Hope [red\\_ella@hotmail.com](mailto:red_ella@hotmail.com). Loss to follow up defined as not attended clinic for greater than 1 year hence suggestion that only those who have left paediatric care 1 year previously to be included. Focused on medical outcomes as aligned with CHIPS/Seroconverter study data collection.
