1. Voluntary Sector and the NHS – Nimisha Tanna

New peer support pilot project being set up at St George's for young adults 18-25 yrs

Funding for 1 year of £3,500 from PCT.

Mentors being currently trained at Body and Soul and will be supported by Health advisors and Body and Soul.

Will also look at how mentors can engage with clients in between appts.

Feedback and report timeline – 6mths.

2. Neurocognitive Study St Mary's – Dr Jane Ashby

Study update

30 completed cases (HIV +ve) 12 controls (HIV –ve siblings/close family member)

Controls difficult to recruit: Spoke at Body and Soul and +ve response re assistance from family members and also been sent additional details others HIV affected

Inc Criteria: 16-25 yrs

Case Perinatal HIV infection

Control HIV+ve sibling or close family member

Ability to have informed consent

3. AALPHI – Ali Judd

Longitudinal Study with 5 yrs FU – majority of funding secured but require some additional funding for substudies

Age 14 yrs onwards: 400 cases (HIV+ve)

300 controls (HIV –ve) siblings affected by HIV

Y1 - Face to Face interview

Y2 – Webcast interview

Y3 – Face to Face interview

Y4 – Webcast interview

Y5 - Face to Face interview

Research nurse or psychologist to conduct interviews – can be based at MRC or within a clinical setting -2 fulltime posts to be advertised shortly.

Budget for reimbursement for participant time - £30 per case £50 per control – control additional cost for travel/lunch for control

4. Bone Health– Dr Daniella Chiltern

Proposed setting up of adolescent metabolic guidelines re low calcium and high ALP in this population – generally felt this would be difficult to do as not even fully established in adults

Pro Bono Study Dr Barry Peters – Adult longitudinal study looking at

Cases - HIV+ve bone mass and markers

Controls - HIV-ve bone mass and marker

Possibility of looking to include adolescents within study one possibility to recruit via AALPHI study or sub study (would require additional funding) – DEXA and repeat in 5 yrs
GOS and St Mary's have some historical DEXA data which could also be reviewed
Daniella to produce proposal.

5. HYPNet audits

2010 – Perinatal pregnancy final data being collected on pregnancy outcomes and paper draft 2 ongoing.

2011- Cervical Smears

Adolescents/young adult females aged 20 and over who have smear and go onto have colposcopy – perinatal and horizontally acquired -**Daniella to lead on this audit for HYPNet**
Perinatal infected girls 20-25yrs – proposal to think about study looking at HPV typing this would need funding for HPV typing

2011- Mortality in perinatally infected young adults age 16 and over – some data may be lost if not followed in CHIPS but linkafe with HPA and CHIPS and centres participating in HYPnet to describe small numbers of deaths: MDR/OI /malignancy/other and role of poor adherence – **Caroline to plan with Pat Tookey and Ali Judd**

6. Guidelines – Dr Caroline Foster

Sexual Health – now completed and being finalised by Dr M T-Flowers

Tibotec have funded 1000 copy print run of the leaflets

Adherence – 138 questionnaires completed and returned to Susan McDonald is now analysing data to report back to HYPNet and present at CHIVA Oct 8th
Proposed submitting to BHIVA for 2011 deadline for abstract submission Jan 2011

Treatment – Will be once adherence guidance completed

Transition – recently updated for CHIVA by CF
