2 Trials nurses have been recruited, neurocognitive, cardiovascular and bone substudy groups have met. Steering committee in the summer and then it is hoped to start recruitment late autumn. Wider cohort data collection may be available in the future for all of CHIPS through the Seroconverters Register – this is a consented study and the perinatal group would fit well in many ways. Ali is liaising with the study group.

Adherence

Caroline has circulated the first draft to the adherence group – after their comments it will be circulated to HYPNet for further advice. Aimed 12-24 who are fully informed of their status. Martha Le Provost will kindly liaise with CHIVA group who are doing the 0-12 years.

7. Vaccinations – Body and Soul raised the issue of peer supporters not having serological evidence of protection esp to MMR preventing them from working in the clinics and potentially being at risk from preventable diseases themselves. Difficulties in getting liaison between the clinics and the GPs to get catch up vaccination. Led to a wider discussion on vaccination in adolescents and the need for guidelines.

Alasdair Bamford who wrote the new CHIVA Vaccine Guidelines has agreed to speak at the next meeting. Caroline circulated a copy of “Vaccine Update” suggesting catch up vaccinations for work purposes should be through Occupational Health of the employing Trust however monitoring by clinics is especially important given the European measles rising incidence and rubella status for young women of child bearing age.

8. Chair – Several people were interested in chairing/co-chairing but due to work/personal commitments would prefer a summer 2012 start – Caroline **has agreed to chair for another year allowing the committee to change in January to avoid everyone changing at once.**
