2. AALPHI and Seroconvertors Update

AALPHI recruitment slowly increasing – negative controls remain difficult to recruit. Research nursing time increased with some paediatric CNSs being trained to undertake screening and interviews. Case note review forms are circulating – the AALPHI nurses will complete but will need help from the clinic teams for missing data.

All 16+ with PaHIV should be recruited to Seroconverter study as a follow on from CHIPS. Only 14 so far recruited. Recruitment and consent in paediatrics prior to transfer to adult care with catch up of those who have already transferred. Lousie at CHIPS@ctu.mrc.ac.uk is managing the study and has been asked to provide a trial file with prefilled consent forms, patient list, information sheets for each site. The cost of 10 pounds/ form annually and 5 pounds/ back data form was seen as insufficient for some adult sites with larger cohorts as insufficient to fund a research nurse to complete. Issues also raised re blood taking and whether samples taken in evening clinics could be stored overnight in a fridge – MRC will clarify. AALPHI nurses will consent those who are also doing the AALPHI study to reduce clinic workload.

3. Sexual Health Audit
