**HYPNet Psychology Audit** – Presented as oral at BHIVA and won best oral prize at CHIVA – is now being written up as a paper by Ellen Dwyer (abstract on website)

### 2. Psychology Projects

Michaeli Evangel

3 papers from Clare Greenhalghs project on intimate relationships in young adults with perinatally acquired HIV– first is published in AIDS Care

Further projects suggested included young adults avoiding relationships and the role of social media in HIV disclosure.
